TIPS&IECHNIQUES

BAKING SODA & CRAYON STAINS & SCUFF MARKS

Put baking soda on a wet sponge and use it to remove crayon stains off walls. You can also use this to remove pencil marks, markers, and grease.

Make a paste of baking soda and water to remove scuff marks off of linoleum floors.

SPRING CLEANING TIPS

- Clean the grungiest windows with a wet sponge sprinkled with baking soda. Rinse the window and dry.
- Clean any floor that can be cleaned with a wet solution with a mixture of 2 gallons of water, half a cap of liquid soap, and 1 cup of vinegar. Wipe the floor dry with a soft cloth to pick up the loosened dirt.
- Get tid of mildew, dust and stale odors by wiping down walls with undiluted vinegar using a cloth or a sponge mop.
- Scrub fireplace bricks with undiluted vinegar to remove soot and grime. Use a brush to scrub and a towel to blot up the wetness and dirt.
- Fireplace doors can be cleaned with a mixture of 1 part vinegar to 2 parts water. Wipe clean with a dry cloth.
- Sprinkle indoor welcome mats with baking soda to clean and deodorize. Then, vacuum.
