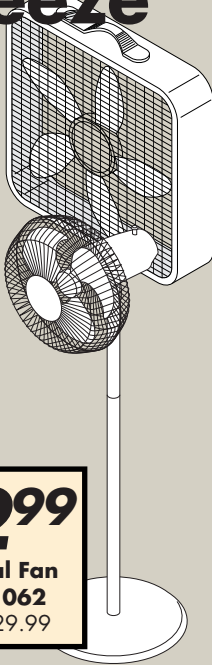

TIPS & TECHNIQUES

USE FANS TO KEEP MOSQUITOES FROM FEASTING ON YOU

While there are many bug fighting measures, the air movement coming from a fan keeps most bugs at bay since it makes landing on your skin something of an effort (think turbulence!). Besides that, a fan disperses the carbon dioxide you exhale. Carbon dioxide is one of the major chemicals that attracts mosquitoes.

GETTING RID OF MOLES

Combine 1/4 cup unrefined castor oil, 2 tablespoons liquid dish soap and 6 tablespoons tap water and mix until combined (having a blender helps!). Combine 2 tablespoons of the mixture with 1 gallon of water in a pressurized sprayer. Coat the garden and grass areas where the moles have invaded with this mixture. Make sure you cover your entire yard. This mixture makes their food (grubs, earthworms, etc.) unappetizing and encourages them to head off to tastier locations.

CHALK LINES DETER ANTS

Keep ants out of your house by drawing chalk lines around areas they come in. For some reason, ants don't like having the chalk dust stick to their feet or simply do not like calcium carbonate.

KEEPING PAINT BRUSHES

The textbook method of storing your good paint brushes is to wash them out in solvent (if you're working on an oil-based paint or varnish), then clean them with soap (or shampoo) and warm water. If you're like the rest of us, you'd just wrap the brush in plastic, eventually forget about it and throw it away later.

A better method is to leave the brush in the paint can. It'll stay good as long as the paint does. That's how most professional painters do it!
