TIPS& techniques

GROUT CLEANING WITH SANDPAPER

Remove stubborn stains along grout lines with fine grit sandpaper. Fold the sandpaper and use the folded edge to sand the stain off the grout seam. Be careful not to sand the tile!

SANDPAPER: SLUG DETERRENT

Place used sanding disks underneath plant pots to deter slugs. You can also cut used sandpaper into strips and tape them around pots.
